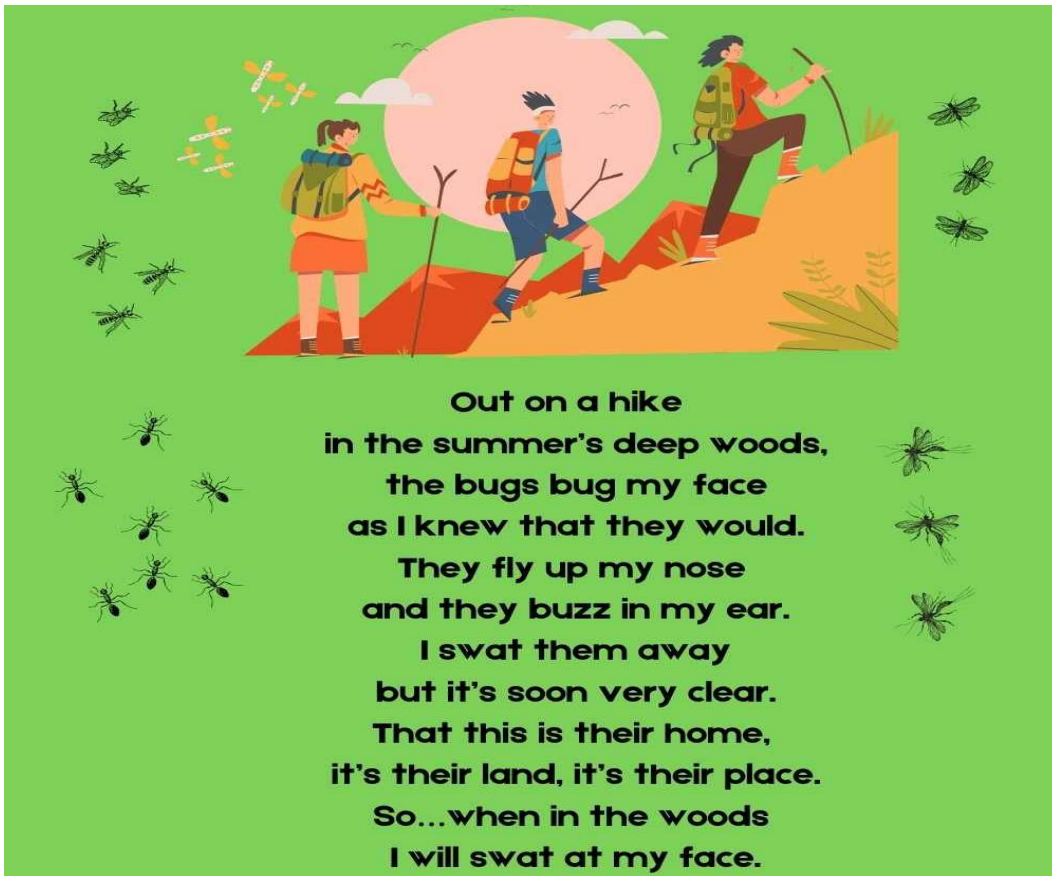
➤ **Prepare a folder, decorate it and bring your all holidays' activities in it.**

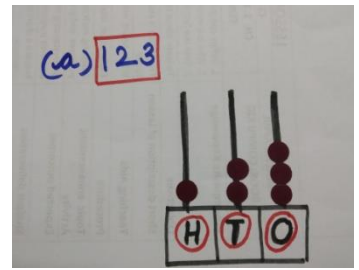

Q.1 What is Computer?

Ans: Introduction of computer:-

- Computer is an electronic machine developed by human beings.
- It takes input from user.
- It processes input data and gives output (result).
- It makes our work faster and easier.
- It is multitasking machine.

Q.6 Explain Central Processing Unit.

Ans: The Central Processing Unit (CPU) processes the input data and produces an output. The CPU is called Processing device. It is the brain of computer. It controls all the parts of the computer system.

Q.7 Explain Memory of a Computer?

Ans: A large amount of data can be stored on the computer. To store the data, the computer has a memory inside its CPU. This memory is called the **Hard Disk**. Some external memories such as **DVD-ROM**, **CD-ROM** and **Pen drive** are used to store the data.

Q.8 What are features or qualities of Computer?

Ans: Computer has many unique features that make it truly an amazing machine. Some of them are:

1. **Fast**- it works really very fast.
2. **Accurate**- it processes the data accurately.
3. **Not get tired**- it does not get bored and tired.
4. **Multitasking**- it can do more than one task at a time.
5. **Storing data**- it can store a large amount of data.

Q.9 How many types of Computers are there?

Ans: 1. Personal Computers (PCs)- These types of computers are made to use by one person at a time.

Examples- Desktop, Laptop and palmtop computers are called Personal Computers.

Name	Size	Speed
Laptop Computers	Small	Good
Palmtop Computers	Very Small (eg- Tablet)	Good
Desktop	Medium	Good

2. Workstation- It looks like a desktop computer. It is faster and more powerful than a desktop computer. It is used in graphic designing, animation and in developing the games.

3. Mainframe Computer- Mainframe is a very large, fast and powerful computer. Some mainframe computers are so large that they occupy as much large space as of a room. It is used in big organisations where large amount of data is required. More than hundred peoples can use the Mainframe computer at the same time.

4. Super Computer- Super Computer is the largest and fastest of all types of computers. It can process very large amount of data very quickly. A Super computer is used in big organisations and government Sectors. It helps in complex tasks such as weather forecast, climatic research and rocket launch. It is used in defence and atomic research.

Q.10 How do you shut down computer? Write steps.
